WEDDINGS: By appointment, at least 6 months notice is essential. Phone the Office for details.



Our Parish and the COVID protocols:

+ 100 attendees are allowed in the church. All MUST be seated as per the protocols of one person per 4 square metres (no standing around the walls).

+ NO need to register at the parish office. There are attendance sheets at each entrance of the church to sign in. (Please be mindful of hygiene practices, there are sanitisers available to use before/after you use the pen to sign in).

+ Sunday Obligation is STILL suspended. With 300 people being allowed at normal weekend Masses, that accommodates less than half of our regular Parishioners. so our Parish Council is requesting that people use one of the week day Masses OR consider attending a weekend Mass fortnightly to meet your wish to attend Mass.

+ There are no longer any collection bags being passed in the church. There are four collection points located at our entrances and these accommodate TapnGo, Planned Giving envelopes and other offerings. We need to discourage the use of coins please.

+ Please assist the parish by helping to wipe down the pews after each Mass. Equipment is supplied.

+ Take the parish bulletin home please.



Sacramental Programmes for 2020

First Holy Communion - Due to the Covid-19 restrictions on Mass attendance numbers, our Parish is offering spaces to our First Communion candidates from five (5) families with their immediate family only at any Weekend Mass in the month of August.
