Eucharistic Adoration Fridays in Lent begins 7 Mar Volunteers to please enter their name on the sign up sheet in the main foyer. You will commit to 1 hour of prayer in the church, between 10am & 9pm. Please speak with Fr Emil if you need guidance.

- Ash Wednesday (5 Mar) & Good Friday (18 Apr) are days of fast & abstinence (no meat). The law of fasting binds those who have completed their eighteenth year, until the beginning of their sixtieth year; the law of abstinence binds those who have completed their fourteenth year.
- ◆ In Lent, the "Alleluia" is omitted at Mass.
- Catholics are obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year, between Ash Wednesday & Trinity Sunday (15 June 2025).
